The 10 Steps to SPeD Testing

1. Notify your supervisor of your intent to participate in the SPeD Certification Program.
2. Log into the existing your Security, Training, Education, and Professionalization System (STEP) account. If you have previously participated in the SPeD Certification Program, have a My SPeD Certification (MSC) account, and have listed it as a program you testing facility, skip to step 7.
3. Go to your profile page in STEP by selecting the profile link located on the top right navigation bar.
