

DoD Security Specialist Course



Course is administered in two phases:

- **Phase I:** eLearning courses (DoD Security Specialist Curriculum, GS020.CU)
- **Phase II:** the instructor-led course

Major areas covered include General Security, Industrial Security, Personnel Security, Information Security, and Physical Security.

Audience: Course is for entry-level DoD and Federal agency civilian, military, and contractor security professionals.

 **DoD SSC ILT** **CDSE**


- DoD SSC Instructor-led Training (ILT) is delivered synchronously
- Multiple instructors deliver the blocks of instruction
- Students complete group and individual learning activities (practical exercises, quizzes, presentation)
- Length is seven days


