

Background / The Requirement

- **The Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)**
 - (Section 4.403, Contracting Officer's Responsibilities and clause 52.204-2, Security requirements)
- **The DD Form 254**
 - Manual paper driven
 - No central repository

Introducing the NISP Contract Classification System (NCCS)

The Goal of NCCS is:

- Establish a DD Form 254 repository
- Improve security controls and quality of data
- Limit the use of paper DD Form 254s
- Ensure data is maintained in one centralized/secure location
- Provides notification capabilities for/between NCCS users
- Minimizes contract security classification specification errors
- Improve the contract award process
- Support the NISP facility clearance and FOCI oversight mission

Getting Started

- Work Station Configuration: Machine setup (9-steps to verify)

- SAR
- Location Code: determines Group Assignment
 - DoDAAC – Department of Defense Activity Address Code
 - GSA AAC – Activity Address Code (41 CFR 101-26.203)
 - CAGE – Commercial and Government Entity

Getting Started cont.

- Role within the process:
 - Originator Access – Allows users to initiate, save, resubmit, and void
 - Reviewer Access – Allows users to recommend certification, reject, hold, or recall
 - Certifying Official Access – Allows users to certify, reject, hold, or recall
 - NISP Oversight (DSS Only)
 - FCL Request Reviewer (DSS Only)




Status

- Initial Operational Capability (IOC) deployed 8 June 2015!
 - Established an Operational Requirements Committee to govern future NCCS requirement vetting and releases...
- Industrial Security Facilities Database (ISFD) interface with NCCS will be released Nov 2015
 - Established interface with WAWF Electronic Document Access
 - Facility Clearance Request process as a incorporated and stand alone process
 - Enhanced search capabilities
