

Walter Kendall Myers was a former State Department official who, with his wife, Gwendolyn Steingraber Myers, participated in a nearly 30-year conspiracy to provide highly classified U.S. national defense information to the Republic of Cuba.

In 2009, the FBI launched an investigation into the pair. The Myerses met four times with an undercover FBI source, during which they made statements about past activities on behalf of the Cuban Intelligence Service, and Walter declared that he had leaked Top Secret defense information related to sources and methods of gathering intelligence to his Cuban handlers.

Walter, "Agent 202," plead guilty to conspiracy to commit espionage and two counts of wire fraud. He was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole. Gwendolyn, aka "Agent 123," plead guilty to conspiracy to gather and transmit national defense information. She received 81 months in prison.
