- · Unauthorized access
- · Denial of service
- · Malware infection
- Data spillage

CAT 2: Denial of Service


CAT 3: Malicious Code

# Incident Response Develop a plan Make sure employees are aware of their responsibilities Test it regularly (at least annually)

# An Incident Response Plan:

4. goto 1

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- Provides a road map for incident response
- Describes the structure / organization of the incident response capability
- Provides a high-level approach
- · Is tailored to the organization
- · Defines reportable incidents

# Incident Response Plan (cont)

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- Provides metrics for measuring the capability within the organization
- Defines the resources and management roles
- Reviewed and approved by leadership
- Is integrated across sections/divisions/elements
