



## PDU Category Fact Sheet

Qualifying Professional Development Activities: To accrue PDUs, a certification holder must participate in and successfully complete professional development activities that fall under one or more of the approved professional development categories.

<b>PDU Category 1: New Certification or Credential</b>
<p>1A: New SPēD or APC Certification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each New SPēD or APC Certification is valued at 100 PDUs.</li> </ul>
<p>1B: SPēD Credential or the DPAPC:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each SPēD Credential or the DPAPC is valued at 75 PDUs.</li> </ul>
<p>1C: Non SPēD or APC Certification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each Non-SPēD Certification is valued at 50 PDUs.</li> </ul>
<b>PDU Category 2: Security-Related Training</b>
<p>2A: Security Related eLearning Course:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each Hour of Security-Related eLearning Course earns 1 PDU. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All 100 PDUs can be earned in this category</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p>2B: Security Related Instructor-Led Training (ILT) or Virtual Instructor-led Training (VILT) Courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each <u>FULL DAY</u> of Security Related Instructor-Led or Virtually-Led Training Courses earns 10 PDUs. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 PDUs for each ½ day (1-4 hours) and 10 PDUs per FULL day (5-8 hours)</li> <li>• All 100 PDUs can be earned in this category</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p>2C: Security Related Higher Education:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each <u>WEEK</u> of Security Higher Education earns 10 PDUs. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For example, 8 weeks = 80 PDUs. All 100 PDUs can be earned in this category</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>PDU Category 3: Non-Security Related Training</b>
<p>3A: Non-Security Related eLearning Training Courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each Hour of Non-Security-Related eLearning Training Courses earns 1 PDU. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Up to 50 PDUs can be earned in this category</li> <li>• Other 50 PDUs must be directly security related</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p>3B: Non-Security Related ILT or VILT Courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each <u>FULL DAY</u> of Non-Security Related ILT or VILT Courses earns 10 PDUs. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 PDUs for each ½ day (1-4 hours) and 10 PDUs per FULL day (5-8 hours)</li> <li>• Up to 50 PDUs can be earned in this category</li> <li>• Other 50 PDUs must be directly security related</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p>3C: Non-Security Related Higher Education:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each <u>WEEK</u> of Non-Security Higher Education earns 10 PDUs. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For example, 8 weeks = 80 PDUs. However, only <u>50 PDUs</u> can be earned in this category</li> <li>• Other 50 PDUs must be directly security related</li> </ul> </li> </ul>



<b>PDU Category 4: Security Conferences</b>
<p>4A: Security Conference: Participant:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each Hour of Security Conference as a Participant is worth 1 PDU.</li> <li>○ All 100 PDUs can be earned in this category.</li> </ul>
<p>4B: Security Conference: Presenter:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Each presentation is worth 5 PDUs, with a max of 25 per event (total of 5 presentations).</li> <li>○ All 100 PDUs can be earned in this category.</li> </ul>
<b>PDU Category 5: Security-Related Projects</b>
<p>5A: SPēD Certification Projects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Certificants can receive three PDUs per contact hour and two PDUs per completed homework assignment for a distinct project.</li> <li>○ Certificants can earn five PDUs per SPēD related survey.</li> <li>○ A maximum of 50 PDUs can be earned for each SPēD Certification and Credentialing Program project.</li> <li>○ All 100 PDUs can be earned in this category.</li> </ul>
<p>5B: Non SPēD Certification Projects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Certificants can receive three PDUs per contact hour and two PDUs per completed homework assignment for a distinct project.</li> <li>○ A maximum of 50 PDUs can be earned for each non-SPēD Certification and Credentialing Program project.</li> <li>○ A maximum of 50 PDUs can be earned in this category.</li> <li>○ Other 50 PDUs must be directly security related.</li> </ul>
<b>PDU Category 6: Other Professionalization</b>
<p>6A: Other Voluntary Professionalization Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Certificants can received 2 PDUs per contact hour.</li> <li>○ A maximum of 50 PDUs can be earned in this category.</li> <li>○ Other 50 PDUs must be directly security related.</li> </ul>
