CREDIT RECOMMENDATIONS

All Education courses have been evaluated by the American Council on Education (ACE) for credit recommendations. The ACE CollegeCredit Recommendation Service (CREDIT®) connects CDSE workplace learning with colleges and universities by helping employees gain access to academic credit for formal courses and examinations taken outside traditional degree programs. ACE credit recommendations allow students to transfer credit earned from approved courses toward completion of degree programs. POST-BACCALAUREATE EDUCATION CERTIFICATES (PBC)

The CDSE Education Program offers post-baccalaureate certificates in five concentrations. Students can earn Education Certificates in Risk Management, Security Leadership, Security Management, Security (Generalist), and for Systems and Operations by completing the required four courses. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT UNITS

Students who complete these courses will earn 160 Professional Development Units (PDUs) for a 16-week course and 80 PDUs for an 8-week course as determined by the Department of Defense Security Training Council, toward maintenance of Security Professional Education Development (SPeD) Program Certification.
