




SECTION 811 REFERRAL

INTRODUCTION

Section 811 of FY1995 Intelligence Authorization

Act mandates the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) is advised immediately of any information, regardless of its origin, which indicates that classified information is being, or may have been, disclosed in an unauthorized manner to an agent of a foreign power.


