

NATO Sub-Registry



- The Registry System
- The Central United States Registry (CUSR)
- DCSA NATO Sub-Registry

Provides NATO Security Guidance on:

- Receiving, controlling, transmitting, storing, reproducing, and destroying NATO classified
- NATO personnel security procedures
- NATO security briefings



NATO Control Point



- What is a NATO Control Point?
- Should your facility be an NCP?
 - Is your facility currently performing on an active NATO contract?
 - Does your facility currently safeguard NATO Secret and/or above on a continual basis?

Establishment is required when a facility has a need to safeguard NATO Secret and above on a continual basis in performance of an active contract.

Establishment Process



Determination

- Notifications, upon NATO contract award
 - DCSA Sub-Registry dcsa.stanag@mail.mil
 - Your IS Rep
- Telephonic Interview

Establishment

- Formal notification
- Only valid for the duration of the contract

NATO Control Point Officer



- Appoint a primary and alternate
- Manages security requirements of the NATO Program
 - Physical Security
 - Information Security
 - Personnel Security

NATO Control Point Requirements



- Inspection
- Security
 - Accountability
 - Annual Inventory and Reporting
 - Safeguarding
 - Labeling and Marking

Disestablishment



Process

- NCP notifies Sub-Registry upon completion of contract
- Submission of destruction certificates and accountability receipts
- Employees debriefed

Notification

Issued by Sub-Registry
