Job Aid: Special Access Program (SAP) Types and Categories

Special Access Program (SAP)

"A program established for a specific class of classified information that imposes safeguarding and access requirements that exceed those normally required for information at the same classification level" (DoDD 5205.07)

SAP Types

Type:	Acknowledged	Unacknowledged	Waived
Description:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Existence is acknowledged, affirmed, or made known to others (that is, it may be openly recognized or publically acknowledged) Purpose is identified 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enhanced security measures ensure that the existence of the program is not acknowledged, affirmed, or made known to any person not authorized for such information (that is, it is not openly recognized or publically 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Type of unacknowledged SAP in which access is extremely limited in accordance with the statutory authority of 10 U.S.C. Section 119 Reporting and access controls are more
