The Defense Security Service, Center for Development of Security Excellence (CDSE), Education Division, offers a curriculum of advanced and graduate courses. The CDSE Education curriculum is designed for DoD security professionals seeking to broaden their knowledge and understanding of the security profession. All of the courses are tuition free and offered in a virtual instructor-led environment. CDSE is accredited by the Council on Occupational Education (COE), a national accrediting authority recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.

CREDIT RECOMMENDATIONS

All of the Education courses have been evaluated by the American Council on Education (ACE) for credit recommendations. The ACE College Credit Recommendation Service (CREDIT) connects CDSE workplace learning with colleges and universities by helping employees gain access to academic credit for formal courses and examinations taken outside traditional degree programs. ACE credit recommendations allow students to transfer credit earned from approved courses toward completion of degree programs. EDUCATION CERTIFICATES

The CDSE Education Program offers Certificates in five concentrations. Students can earn Education Certificates in Risk Management, Security Leadership, Security Management, Security (Generalist), and for Systems and Operations by completing the required four courses. CDSE does not grant degrees at this time.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT UNITS

Students who complete these courses will earn 45 Professional Development Units (PDUs), as determined by the Department of Defense Security Training Council, toward maintenance of Security Professional Education Development (SPeD) Program certification.

REQUIREMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Course/Program enrollment:

- Registration is restricted to U.S. Government civilian employees and U.S. military service members.
- Some courses require a Secret security clearance.
- Some courses require the purchase of textbooks.
- Security Fundamentals Professional Certification is required for the course ED501 and recommended for all other courses.

Student success:

- Students must complete reading, research, and writing assignments similar to a university graduate program.
- Students who have no experience taking graduate courses are encouraged to complete the course ED 201, "Writing and Communication Skills for Security Professionals," before taking other courses in this curriculum.
- Please consider adding one or more of these courses to your Individual Development Plan (IDP).
